CHAT SOMEONE UP

ASK SOMEONE OUT

TO ASK SOMEONE TO GO ON A DATE WITH YOU.



STAND SOMEONE UP

IF SOMEONE IS "STOOD UP", THE PERSON THEY'RE WAITING TO SEE DOESN'T ARRIVE, OFTEN LEAVING THEM WAITING IN THE STREET.



GO OUT WITH SOMEONE

TO HAVE A ROMANTIC RELATIONSHIP WITH SOMEONE.



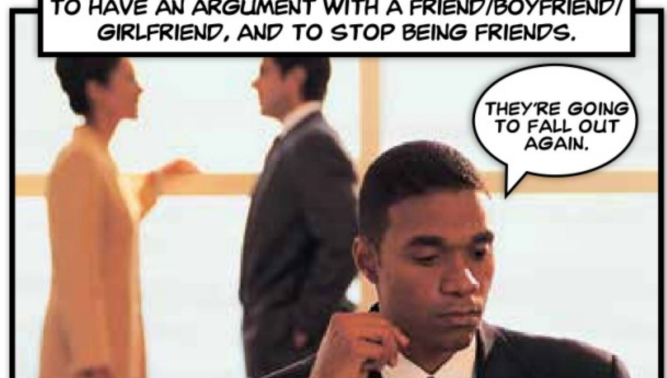
CHEAT ON SOMEONE

TO HAVE AN AFFAIR WITH SOMEONE WHO IS NOT YOUR HUSBAND/WIFE/BOYFRIEND/GIRLFRIEND.



FALL OUT

TO HAVE AN ARGUMENT WITH A FRIEND/BOYFRIEND/GIRLFRIEND, AND TO STOP BEING FRIENDS.



SPLIT UP / BREAK UP
TO STOP THE RELATIONSHIP.



MAKE UP

TO BE FRIENDS AGAIN WITH SOMEONE AFTER AN ARGUMENT.
